"Collaborative Revisions: Reshaping Universal Rights" by Elisa Piazzi and Inna Kochkina delves into the sociopolitical impact of formal language within the framework of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Starting from the analysis of formal language, Inna and Elisa contextualize their research within a broader context by questioning the use of language norms, typographic principles, and elements that portray (or fail to portray) humans and more-then-humans, their rights, and their representation in official documents.

Using critical theory, collective practices, and experimental printing techniques, they aim to challenge the notion of establishing (and write) universal rights without imposing cultural bias and Western systems of beliefs.

Follwing is a series of photos documenting some the workshops. The process began with a collaborative re-writing session of the Declaration of Human Rights, followed by a letter-shaping activity using personal objects and cyanotype printing.






